

Terry Kottman, Ph.D., NCC, RPT-S, LMHC, founded The Encouragement Zone, where she provides play therapy training and “Playshops” for women. Terry developed Adlerian play therapy, an approach to working with children, families, and adults that combines the ideas and techniques of Individual Psychology and Play Therapy. She regularly presents workshops and writes about play therapy. She is the author of *Play Therapy: Basics and Beyond*, co-author (with Kristin Meany-Walen) of *Partners in Play: An Adlerian Approach to Play Therapy* and *Doing Play Therapy: From Building the Relationship to Facilitating Change*, and several other books. In 2014, she won the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Association for Play Therapy, and in 2017, she won a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Iowa Association for Play Therapy.

Doing Play Therapy: From Building the Relationship to Facilitating Change
