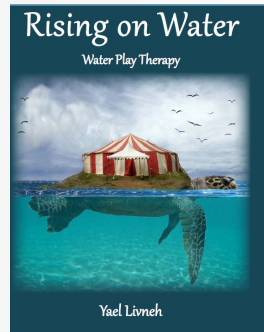

The method is suitable for: Therapists from a variety of fields who would like to extend their professional tools and acquire a very efficient therapeutic tools. Educators who work with children or special needs populations, for the development of emotional intelligence, social skills, self-image and development of thought strategies, creativity and problem solution.

Goals of the Course:

- Extending the 'tool box' available to therapists – participants will learn to use the method in their clinics and how to adapt it to different populations.

- Participants will learn the role of the therapist in Water Play Therapy and will take part in simulation exercises of WPT.
