Dr. Meany-Walen is an RPT-S a Mental Health Coordinator in Waterloo Community Schools where she works with kids, teachers, and parents with the goal

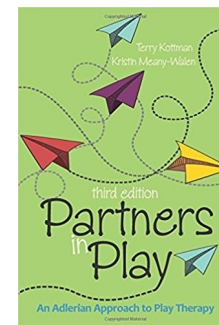

Adlerian play therapy is an adventurous and engaging approach to use with children, building on the expertise of Alfred Adler's Individual Psychology. It facilitates prosocial parent-child interactions and an exploration into the forces influencing maladaptive behaviors. In Adlerian play therapy, clients explore and gain insight into their faulty beliefs and attitudes, goals influencing behavior, and learn strategies to enact change through play and various counseling techniques.

Objectives:

Participants will be able to:

1. Describe rationale for including parent/teacher consultations in Adlerian Play Therapy
2. Use specific strategies for engaging parents/teacher in the therapeutic process of play therapy
3. Design specifically tailored play therapy interventions that respond to children's presenting concerns
4. Describe their own lifestyles according to Adlerian play therapy conceptualization
5. Describe a practical research approach for play therapy
