Adlerian play therapy is a widely used play therapy approach with evidence to support its effectiveness with children. In Adlerian play therapy, therapists work to understand their clients from their unique perspectives and intentionally create interventions that respond to clients' needs, assets, and goals. In this interactive workshop, participants practice conceptualizing clients and creating interventions.
