Adlerian play therapy, based on Adler's Individual Psychology, emphasizes the role of family and social context on children's development and functioning. Parents and teachers are frequently involved in the therapeutic process to aid in children's prosocial changes and maintenance of goals. Participants will learn the rationale for including others in children's therapy and interventions to use with parents, families, and teachers.

Objectives:

- Describe rationale for including parent/teacher consultations in Adlerian Play Therapy
- Use specific strategies for engaging parents/teachers in the therapeutic process of play therapy
- Design specifically tailored play therapy interventions that respond to children's presenting concerns
- Identify parents/teachers personality priorities
- Design specifically tailored play therapy interventions for parents/teachers that respond to children's presenting concerns.

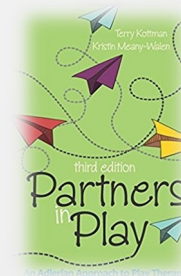
